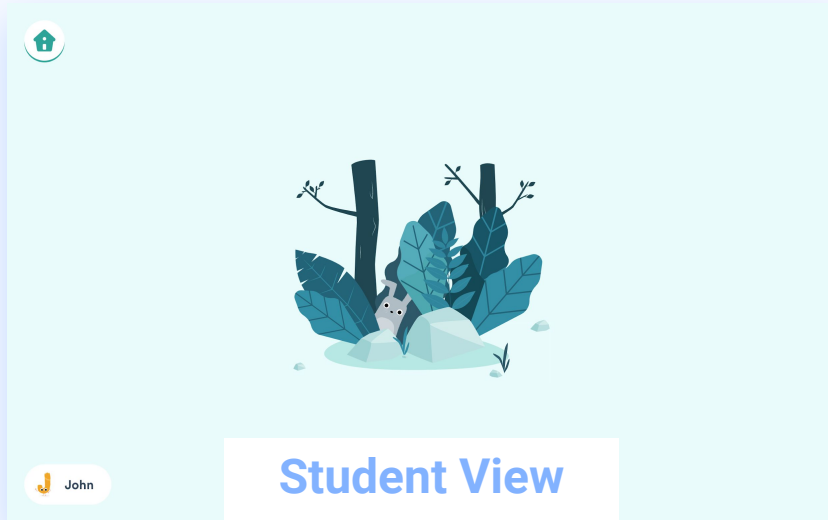

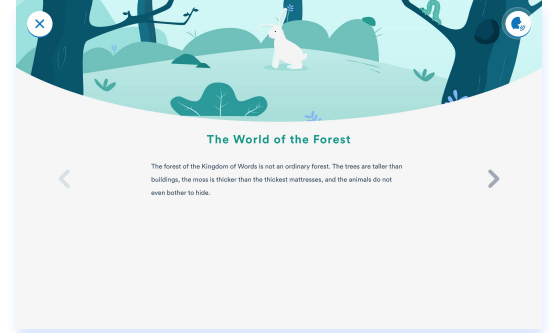
What Do Students Do on Lalilo?



Students work on lessons and as they validate or complete lessons, they move through different worlds, collecting stars and treasures on their map.



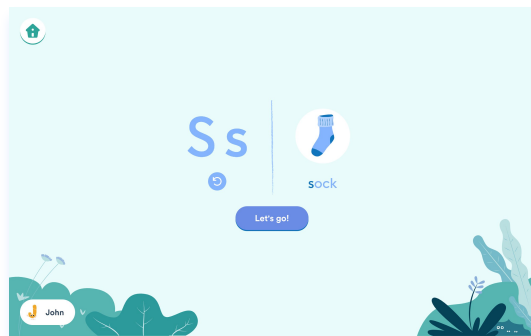
By improving their skills, they earn badges.



They use their badges to unlock stories about animals and nature.

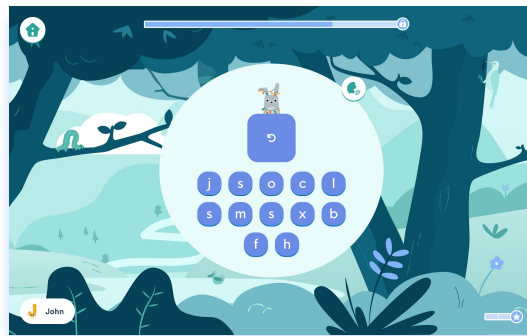

Engagement



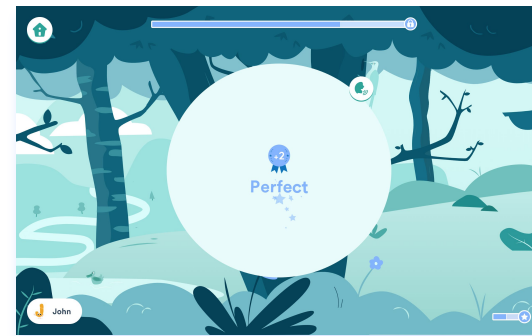
After completing the Placement Test, students work at their own pace through the Lalilo Learning Progression. A variety of different exercises within each lesson keeps things engaging for students.

Lalilo adapts to your students' performance providing content at their correct level of difficulty. Each lesson is scaffolded to meet the needs of each individual student.

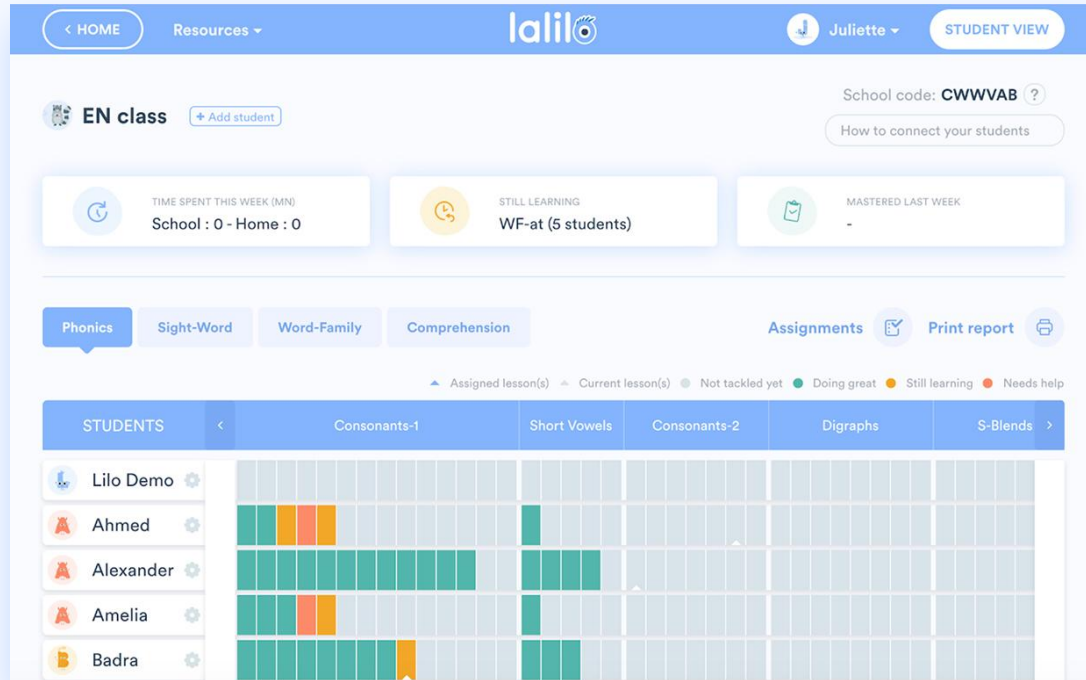
Feedback



Lalilo provides students with immediate feedback as they work. Students can also see their progress on each lesson and exercise.

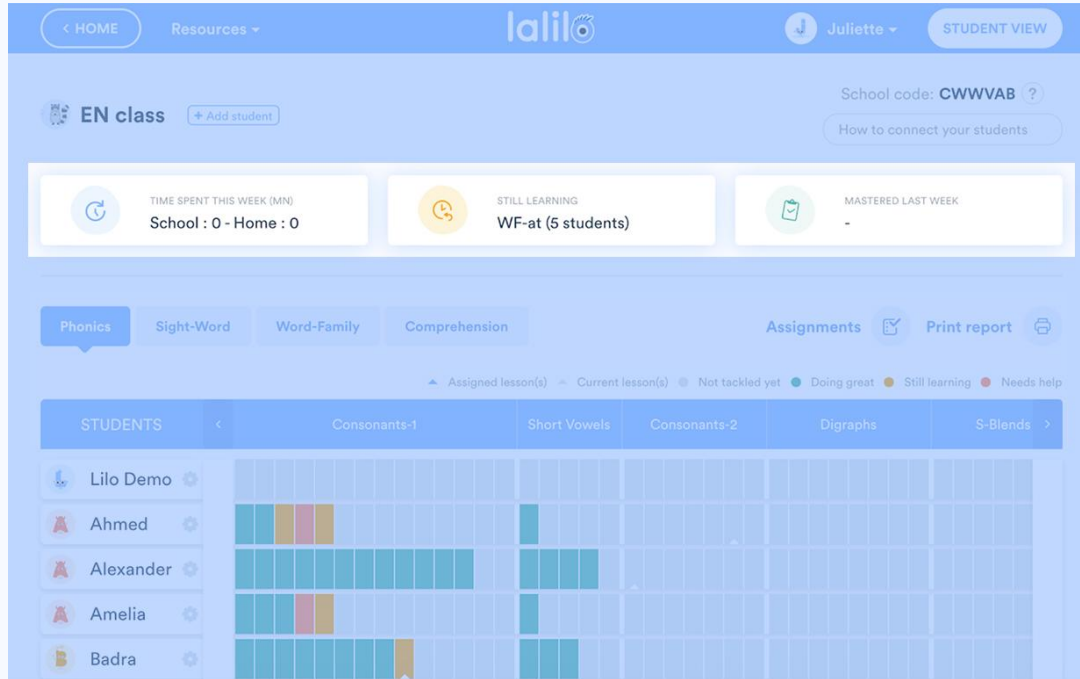

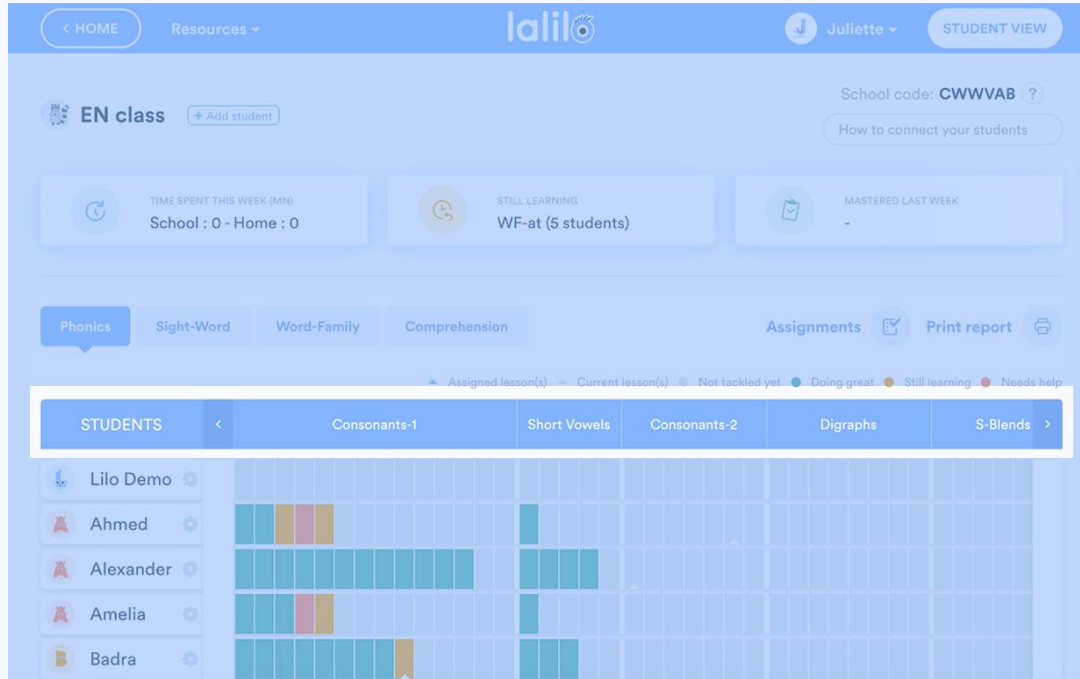

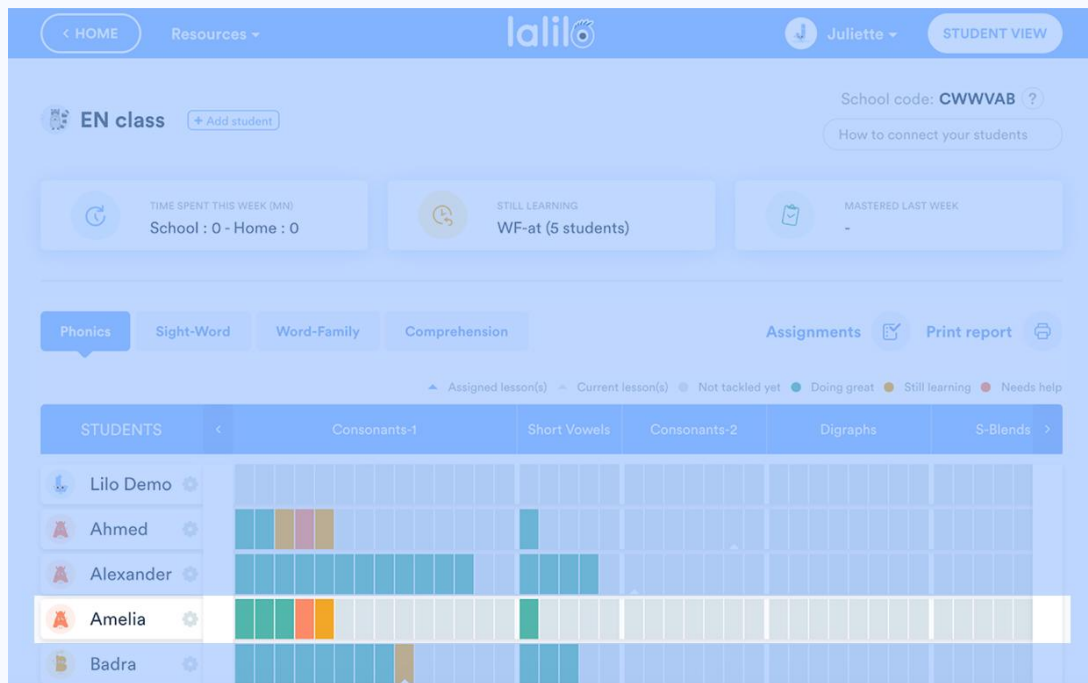

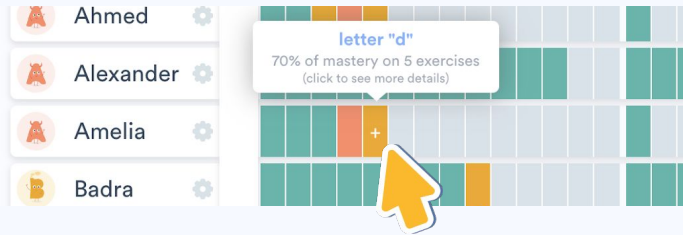
